Makeup Information

- It is important to put some makeup on the dancer's face to help them not look so washed out on stage.
- Younger dancers please apply some lipstick, blush and if your child will tolerate it, mascara.
- Older Dancers please apply full makeup foundation (similar to skin tone), blush, lipstick/liner, eyeshadow, eye liner, and mascara.
- Makeup colors are your preference.
- No bright/odd color nail polish.
- No jewelry should be worn unless it is part of the costume.
